



Our House Rules

General rules:

If you find anything missing in our accommodation, if there is a need for improvement, or if we can be of any assistance, please contact us. We are happy to help. Please treat the furnishings with care. This will ensure that future guests also feel comfortable.

If any damage occurs to the furnishings, please inform us. Please notify us no later than your departure. These matters can usually be resolved quickly and easily through liability insurance. Please also inform colleagues and staff of these house rules.

The Kitchen:

Please wash dishes, cutlery, pots, and pans before departure. This ensures that the next guests will always find clean kitchenware. Please dispose of all food before departure. Please leave the kitchen as you would like to find it on your next visit.

The Bathroom:

Please do not enter the bathroom with outdoor shoes. Please keep the bathroom clean. After showering, please wipe down the shower screen and the floor. Please open the windows for 15 minutes after showering. Turn off the heating during this time. Keep the toilets clean. Please do not dispose of food scraps in the toilet, shower, or sink. Use the provided waste containers instead.

Waste separation:

Please separate the waste into the designated containers.

Heating/Ventilation:

Please ventilate the rooms daily for at least 10 minutes. Turn off the heating when the window is open. Please do not reprogram the heating system.

Non-smoking:

Smoking is not permitted in our accommodation for tradespeople. Please smoke outside.

Our quiet hours/lunchtime:

To ensure that you and your colleagues are well-rested and ready for work tomorrow, please observe our quiet hours. Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m., and lunchtime is from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Your duty of care:

Please close all windows and doors before leaving the accommodation. We accept no liability for break-ins or theft. Please also check that all lights, as well as the stove and oven, are switched off.

Valuables:

The landlord is not liable for valuables or personal belongings.

Keys:

As a tenant, you will receive at least one key from us. The loss of a key necessitates the replacement of the entire locking system. The responsible party will bear the costs.

Parking:

Please use only designated/public parking spaces and observe any parking time restrictions.

Other:

Please do not reprogram devices such as the television.

No one registered on the premises is permitted to stay overnight.

Do not carry furniture from inside the accommodation outside.

Please remove dirty shoes before entering the accommodation.
